
Bonus Workbook:

- Zafèt's Treats: Discuss how she's a strong female character and a role model for kids based on her personality, values, actions, etc.

- Shout Out: Give a shout-out to your family members for something they've helped you with as you've matured and grown. Write a song, poem, rap, or story to honor them.
- Sounds Abound: Identify 2-4 typical Kreyòl sounds from the book.





- Art from the Heart: Which illustration is your favorite? Why?
- Mango Marvels: Recall what you learned about mangos, the rainy season, and other Haitian science and nature facts from this book.
- Sweet Similes: Good authors use similes to compare two unlike things in literature using like or as. Spot 2-4 similes in this book.
- Kreyòl (Haitian Creole) Cheers: Locate and define 2-4 Kreyòl words from the book and translate them into English or your own language/s.

- Divine Dreams: Create a picture or a creative collage about your recent dreams.
- Hello, Haiti: Name 2-4 cultural lessons or insights from this book about Haiti.
- Sweet Siblings: What's the author's message about siblings in this book?
